QUAD Races Rules and Regulations

General Rules

- Dot and Snell approved helmet
- Either a tek-vest or bee wear or a certified MX vest must be worn
- ALL ATV'S MUST HAVE OEM MOTOR THAT FITS THAT OEM FRAME. no exceptions Eg: Raptor motor for raptor frame
- All atv's must have nerf bars
- All atv's must have functional brakes, front and back
- All atv's must have functional tether cord or "dead man's switch"
- All atv's must have functional rear tail light
- All atv's must not be wider than 50" from outside of tire to outside of tire, both front and back
- All atv's must not have any racks of any sort. racks must be removed
- All studs must be of the screw in type, no backers on the inside of the tire
- All studs must be no longer than 5/16" measured from the rubber to the top of the stud head
- All numbers must be 6" high and in a highly visible place
- All atv's must be naturally aspirated. eg: no nitrous, turbo's, superchargers etc.

Stock Class Specs

- General rules still apply
- This class is for all engine sizes both 2 and 4 strokes
- No internal or external engine modifications eg. air filter, cams, pipe, etc. must be stock
- Shock's, tires, axle's, and rim's can be changed
- Maximum of 50" in width outside to outside of tires
- bikes can be no lower than 6in. from the ground to the frame

anything more will move you to mod class.

Mod Class

- General rules still apply
- This class is for all engine sizes both 2 and 4 stroke.
- Motor must be an OEM motor; example no snowmobile or street bike engines
- Engine must be naturally aspirated, meaning no nitrous, turbo charging etc.
- Motor must be ahead of rear axle and behind front a-arm's
- Any other modifications are legal

Utility and 4X4

- All 4X4 must enter this class eg: scramblers, renegades etc.
- All utility atv's must enter this class eg: trail boss etc.
- General rules must still apply
- Equivalent safety to nerf bars must apply eg: runner boards etc (tires must not be able to enter foot well)
